The likelihood of survival increases to **90%** when the victim receives high quality CPR and a shock from an AED within the first 2 minutes of sudden cardiac arrest.



88% of the sudden cardiac arrests that occur yearly will happen at home.



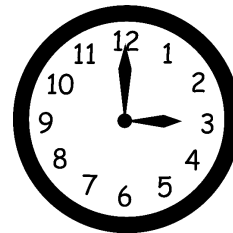
Performing CPR triples a person's chance of survival.
